FACTS		What Does StoneX Do With Your Personal Information?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all, sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Information we receive from you on account opening applications or other forms (for example, your name, address, TIN). • Information about your transactions with us or others (for example, your transaction history, account balance, payment history, or parties to transactions). • Information that we may receive from a consumer reporting agency such as your credit worthiness and credit history. • Information provided via our websites and electronic (including e-mail) or other forms of communications. 	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons StoneX chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do	
How does StoneX protect my personal information?	We limit access to your personal and account information to those employees who have a need to know that information in order for us to provide products, services, support or assistance to you and who have been trained on the proper handling of personal information. We also maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect and guard your nonpublic personal information. If you decide to close your account(s) or become an inactive customer, we will continue to adhere to the privacy policies and practices as described in this or subsequent notices.
How does StoneX collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information when you open an account.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law and regulators require us to collect certain information in order to protect against terrorism, money laundering, and other crimes. We are also required to provide certain information in response to court orders and certain investigations.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include the member companies of StoneX Group Inc.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. We do not participate in joint marketing agreements.

Other Important Information

You have the right to see and, if necessary, correct personal data. This requires a written request, both to see your personal data and to request correction. We do not have to change our records if we do not agree with your correction but we will place your statement in our file.
